## **School News & Updates:**

Daily Pick up/Drop off Procedure Update – Effective Today: The office needs to have documentation of student attendance and whereabouts. This is a liability issue; it is our legal responsibility to confirm where each child is, is going and with whom. If they are not on school transportation after school we need to be able to confirm we were given confirmation by the parent/guardian whom they are leaving with and that they indeed leave with the person specified by the parent. Please remember parents need to call the office if your child's normal bus routine is changing or if they are being picked up. Please email changes or call the office by **2:45pm each day**. The end of the day tends to be very hectic in the office, so this gives us enough time to communicate with each teacher/driver which children are going where. If you email after 2:45 the office may not receive it, if you do not receive a response to your email please come to the office when you pick up your child/ren and confirm with the office where the child went and with whom so that we have documentation (do not just tell the bus driver, please let the office know as well). At the end of the day all children being picked up will be in the front fover by the office. The Office has a list/documentation of who is being picked up, the secretary will let each child/family go when they confirm the parent guardian picking up to the list. So please either give us a wave or make yourself visible so we can confirm all children are safely going with the correct person. Attendance and confirming missing students are a legal obligation as well. So, also, in the morning if your child is absent, please confirm with a call or email to the office. If we do not receive an email/call, the office calls to confirm the missing student with the parent/guardian. Thanks for your assistance with this, any questions do not hesitate to contact Jolene Makkinga, hopefully it is smooth sailing.
